

What We Do With the Money Entrusted to Us.

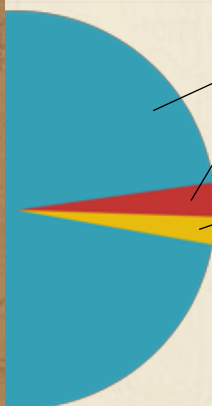
Last year World Concern had 877 staff worldwide, and helped nearly 6 million people through ministry efforts in 22 countries. Our total budget exceeded \$81 million, with over \$77 million going directly to families in need.
