World Concern welcomes Dr. Paul Robinson, MBBS, MTS, MPH, as Director of International Health Programs. Dr. Robinson brings 20 years of international health experience to the organization.

“To bring lasting health and healing to the vulnerable people we serve around the world, we must work with excellence and reflect the compassion of Christ,” said Meredith Long, DrPH, World Concern’s Senior Director for International Programs. “I’m excited that Paul will lead in the development of our health programs.”

As the Director of International Health Programs at World Concern, Dr. Robinson will be responsible for the technical management of our HIV and AIDS programs, and the health training component in our water and sanitation programs, but his primary responsibility will be to work with our overseas offices to build integrated health programs focused on the health of women and children.



“I am absolutely delighted to join the fine team of dedicated professionals who serve God through their ministries,” said Dr. Robinson. “Being born and raised in one of the most resource constrained countries of the world, Bangladesh, it was by God’s grace I have had the opportunities for getting education and experience, which I utilize to help improve the lives of those who are suffering.”

With extensive experience in designing, writing, procuring and managing grants and programs, his background includes positions with Care, John Snow, the American Red Cross, Plan International, UNICEF and Northrup-Grumman’s Global AIDS program.

Dr. Robinson received his MBBS (MD) from the Chittagong Medical College in Chittagong, Bangladesh, a Masters in Theological Studies from the Grand Rapids Theological Seminary, and his MPH in International Health from the Johns Hopkins School of Public Health. A native of Bangladesh, he is fluent in English, Bengali and Urdu, and speaks some French and Spanish.

Dr. Robinson lives with his wife and daughter in Laurel, Maryland and will work remotely from the Washington, D.C. area.
